## Dr. Swearer...

**Dr. Susan M. Swearer** is a Professor of School Psychology at the University of Nebraska – Lincoln (UNL) and Co-Director of the Bullying Research Network (<a href="http://brnet.unl.edu">http://brnet.unl.edu</a>). She is the principal investigator on the *Target Bullying Intervention Program* and has a long-standing track record working with schools nationwide to reduce bullying behaviors. Dr. Swearer has authored over 100 book chapters and articles on the topics of bullying, depression, and anxiety in school-aged youth. Her *Target Bullying Intervention Program* was featured on CBS Sunday Morning in February 2011; she was an invited presenter at the White House Bullying Prevention Conference in March 2011; and she was a panel member at Harvard University of the launch of the Born This Way Foundation along with Lady Gaga, Oprah, Deepak Chopra, and Secretary of HHS Kathleen Sebelieus in February 2012. In March 2012, Dr. Swearer was a featured bullying expert on Anderson Cooper's daytime show, "Anderson."
